

24. PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN CLATSOP COUNTY ROADS AND RIGHTS OF WAY

24.1 DEFINITIONS:

24.1.1 "County Road". A public road under the jurisdiction of the County that has been designated as a County Road under ORS 368.016.

24.1.2 "County Road Right-of-Way". A strip of land of established width as stated in resolution and orders accepting the road as a County Road under ORS 368.016.

24.1.3 "Owner". The registered owner of the vehicle as displaced in the records of the Motor Vehicles Department.

24.1.4 "Motor Vehicle". Any device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a public roadway which is self-propelled or designed for self-propulsion and further includes a "trailer" standing alone or in conjunction with another motor vehicle, "trailer" meaning every vehicle without motive power designed to be drawn by another vehicle. Trailer includes, but is not limited to, the following types of trailers:

- A. Balance trailers
- B. Bus trailers;
- C. Commercial bus trailers;
- D. Farm trailers;
- E. Mobile homes;
- F. Pole trailers;
- G. Semi-trailers;
- H. Travel trailers;
- I. Truck trailers;
- J. Self-supporting trailers; and
- K. Special use trailers.

24.1.5 "Parked Motor Vehicle". A stationary, unoccupied motor vehicle, regardless of whether the engine is running or not. (Ordinance 91-11, Sec. 3)

24.2 PROHIBITIONS

24.2.1 The Clatsop County Roadmaster is authorized to designate which county roads and county rights-of-way shall be subject to the provisions of this Ordinance when, in the

opinion of the Roadmaster, the safe and adequate flow of traffic necessitates the implementation of the provisions of this ordinance. Signs shall be posted to designate the road or right-of-way on which parking is restricted. The action by the Roadmaster so authorized may be taken without any action by the Clatsop County board of Commissioners and/or amendments of this Ordinance.

24.2.2 Except for temporary purposes when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or when in compliance with directives of a peace officer or traffic control device, it shall be unlawful for anyone to:

A. Park a motor vehicle within ten (10) feet of the traveled surfaces of a county road designated pursuant to Section 24.2.1.

B. Park on the right-of-way of a county road designed pursuant to Section 24.2.1. (Ordinance 91-11, Sec. 4 as amended by Ordinance 95-23, Sec. 3)

24.3 CITATION AND PENALTIES

24.3.1 The Clatsop County Sheriff or any Oregon Peace Officer is authorized to cite violators by placing a citation directed to the vehicle's owner upon the windshield of any vehicle found in violation of this ordinance using the Uniform Traffic Citation and according to the terms and conditions cited therein.
