

6. CODIFICATION OF ORDINANCES

6.1 Purpose

6.1.1 Clatsop County Staff has recently completed compilation of all current County ordinances. There is a need to catalogue these ordinances and their provisions in such a way that they may be readily accessible to County staff and to the public. Clatsop County proposes to adopt the Clatsop County Code of Regulations as the format for codification of Clatsop County Ordinances now in effect and hereinafter adopted except with respect to the Clatsop County Land and Water Use and Development Ordinance which will continue to remain in its present form. Citation to the sections found in the Clatsop County Code of Regulations may be made in lieu of citation to the ordinance itself. (Ordinance 91-16, Sec. 2)

6.2 Adoption

6.2.1 The document entitled Clatsop County Code of Regulations presented to the Board of Commissioners on October 9, 1991, is hereby adopted as the official codification of ordinances enacted by Clatsop County. All future ordinances and amendments following adoption, shall be codified in the same format now provided without further order of this Board. In all proceedings citation to the Code of Regulations shall be sufficient when necessary to reference the provisions of any ordinance adopted by the County. In the event of an inconsistency between the ordinance and the code section, the ordinance shall prevail. (Ordinance 91-16, Sec. 3)
