# How is your property tax dollar spent?

When you write your property tax check to Clatsop County, only some of your money goes to the county. We collect the taxes, then distribute the money to 66 taxing districts. This illustration shows how an average tax dollar is divided.

On average, out of every \$1 you pay, just 12.77 cents goes to Clatsop County government.
