Campaign Finance

The following forms may be required by candidates -

The candidate is <u>not required</u> to file a Statement of Organization for Candidate Committee, file campaign finance reports, or establish a campaign account if **ALL THREE** of the following conditions are met:

- the candidate serves as the candidate's own treasurer
- the candidate does not have an existing candidate committee, AND
- the candidate does not expect to receive or spend more than \$750 for the entire election.

However, if at any time the candidate exceeds \$750 in either contributions or expenditures, the candidate must establish a campaign account and file a Statement of Organization within **three business days**, by filing the following forms <u>with the Secretary of State office</u>:

- SEL 220, Statement of Organization for Candidate Committee
- SEL 223, Campaign Account Information

All Statements of Organization, Campaign Account Information and detailed campaign finance transactions **must be filed electronically** with the Secretary of State's Election Division , through the online filing system, **ORESTAR**.
