

On 5/4/2021, at approximately 10:20am, I was dispatched to 38212 Highway 26, Seaside, OR 97138 for a report of a cold burglary called in by the property owner, Trudie Phillips (DOB 12/27/1953). Trudie was advised by dispatch to remain in her car until our arrival.

I met with Trudie at the above address at about 10:40am. Trudie advised me she had been burglarized just a couple weeks prior and was under the impression it was by the same people. At the time, she had an officer take a report but they were unable to determine who the suspect was.

Trudie led me onto her property which was packed with four RV's, one single wide trailer, multiple tents, one out building, and her home in the south west corner of the lot. The property was littered with multiple large piles of children's toys and garbage. Trudie also advised she had been without property to her home since 2016 when the big storm ripped out her power cables.

While walking through her property, Trudie began listing out all of the things she noticed were missing. These included random items such as salt and pepper shakers, family photos, garden statues, cans of food, storage totes, and a few rolls of toilet paper. There was a wheelbarrow at the beginning of her property with a flat front tire. Trudie was under the impression that whomever burglarized her, had been using the wheelbarrow to move the items across her property. Upon quick inspection, the wheelbarrow was sunken into the ground with a thick layer of pine needles laying around it. It appeared to not have moved in a long time.

While walking past one tent, she peered inside and said all of her clamming equipment was missing, however she did not remember what specific equipment it was. The tent where she stored the equipment was also a makeshift bathroom with a commode sitting above a hole in the ground.

All of the dwellings on the property were packed full of random items. When entering into her actual home, I had to step around large piles of books and other belongings on the ground to make my way to the bedroom where Trudie claimed to sleep. The bed was covered with more items, and there was no actual path leading to the bed. In the bedroom, Trudie claimed there was

an old wooden hutch full of World War II equipment, but it was all missing. While leaving the residence, Trudie found one of the missing World War II satchels she originally reported as missing.

During the walk through of Trudie's property and home, Trudie was visibly upset. Multiple times, she had to take a moment to stop crying and continue on with listing what items she was missing. I gave Trudie and Victim's Right's card with a number to call for all of the items she was missing. I also requested she take the time she needed to write up a list of everything she was missing and the value of each items. Finally, I advised Trudie to hang up a camera at the entrance of her property incase she reported another theft.

After leaving the residence, Deputy Shepherd contacted Code enforcement to advise them of the state of the property. They advised they will follow up with Trudie at a later time.



Apologies for the delay in response but Fridays are my Monday.

Both the vehicles you referenced were towed by me utilizing our 24 hour tag and tow capabilities at the beginning of this year. According to my records I tagged them on 12/31/2022 and had them both towed on 01/02/2023. Classic Towing came for the GMC van and Garys Towing came for the Red Mercury. To my knowledge OSP did not bring any charges against the property owner in this instance and since they were towed under a 24 hour tag the tow companies really end up shouldering the financial burden to remove these. The motorhome that is still present is a much more difficult recruitment as far as a tow company willing to come and remove it and it becomes a fairly large financial expense for ODOT to have it removed (typically several thousand dollars).

Worth noting that we have had several instances with this property owner bringing items out to the state right away making ODOT responsible for clean up and disposal. I have records/photos of all instances I have been directly called out to deal with this issue should you need any more information.







- B. The responsible party may present evidence to the code compliance specialist in the course of said review regarding the presence or abatement of the alleged nuisance.
- C. Upon completion of administrative review, the code compliance specialist shall determine the presence and nature of any nuisances.
 - 1. If a nuisance is present the code compliance specialist may issue a separate notice of violation and may schedule the case for review by the hearings officer.
 - 2. If no nuisance is present the code compliance specialist shall dismiss the violation upon full payment of any fines or other penalties assessed for the violation.

In accordance with CCC 1.14.100 the responsible party(s) must appear at the hearing which will be held virtually. If the responsible party(s) does not appear at the hearing or does not submit a written statement in lieu of appearing in person

- The full amount of the proposed civil penalty will be assessed
- The responsible party(s) will be ordered to correct the violation(s)

Failing to pay a civil penalty or correct a violation after having been ordered or required to do so is a separate violation of the code and subjects the responsible party to additional civil penalties, court action, liens, garnishments, interest charges, and other involuntary collection remedies.



Hearing Procedures

The hearings officer shall preside over hearings under this chapter and may set reasonable rules of procedure designed to facilitate orderly and efficient presentation of evidence provided the rules do not conflict with this chapter

Except as otherwise provided, the responsible party must appear in person at the hearing. If the responsible person is an individual, that person may submit a written statement in lieu of personal appearance. This statement must be signed by the responsible party or on behalf of the responsible party and received by the county at least one business day prior to the hearing. All testimony must be given under oath

Responsible parties who are not individuals must designate a director, officer, managing agent, member, or employee who has the authority to act of the responsible party's behalf and to give sworn testimony on the responsible party's behalf. The hearings officer may require the designee to testify under oath to establish the designee's authority.

The county may be represented by a code compliance specialist for violations other than the Building Code or Fire Code, by a legal counsel or assistant legal counsel, by a peace officer, or by any person so authorized by a county department head.

The responsible person may be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Oregon or may represent themselves. The appearance of an attorney does not alter the requirement that the responsible party be personally present at the hearing.

The county shall proceed first and have the burden of establishing the violations by a preponderance of evidence.

The responsible party proceeds second and, if personally present, may question the county's witnesses, present testimony and evidence and make argument*.

The county's representative may question the responsible party's witnesses. The county may offer rebuttal testimony or argument or both at the discretion of the hearings officer.

*If the responsible party is not personally present, the hearings officer may not consider any testimony, argument or evidence on behalf of the responsible party apart from the responsible party's written statement
