Justice Reinvestment Grant Reporting

Equipment for P&P:

Parole and Probation is looking into GC-MS Testing equipment and a GPS based alcohol monitoring system to see if they would be something they should purchase.

They are also looking into what would be the best computers to purchase for field work. These would be shared computers so only two or three will be needed.

Other Business

Brian Mahoney reported on the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program grant. Using Federal funds this grant will be used to hire a coordinator to visit opioid prescribers and get them registered with the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP). The PDMP is a national and voluntary program. The program helps doctors track if patients are also getting prescriptions elsewhere and if prescribing will be helpful or if the client would be better served by moving into pain management through other means.
